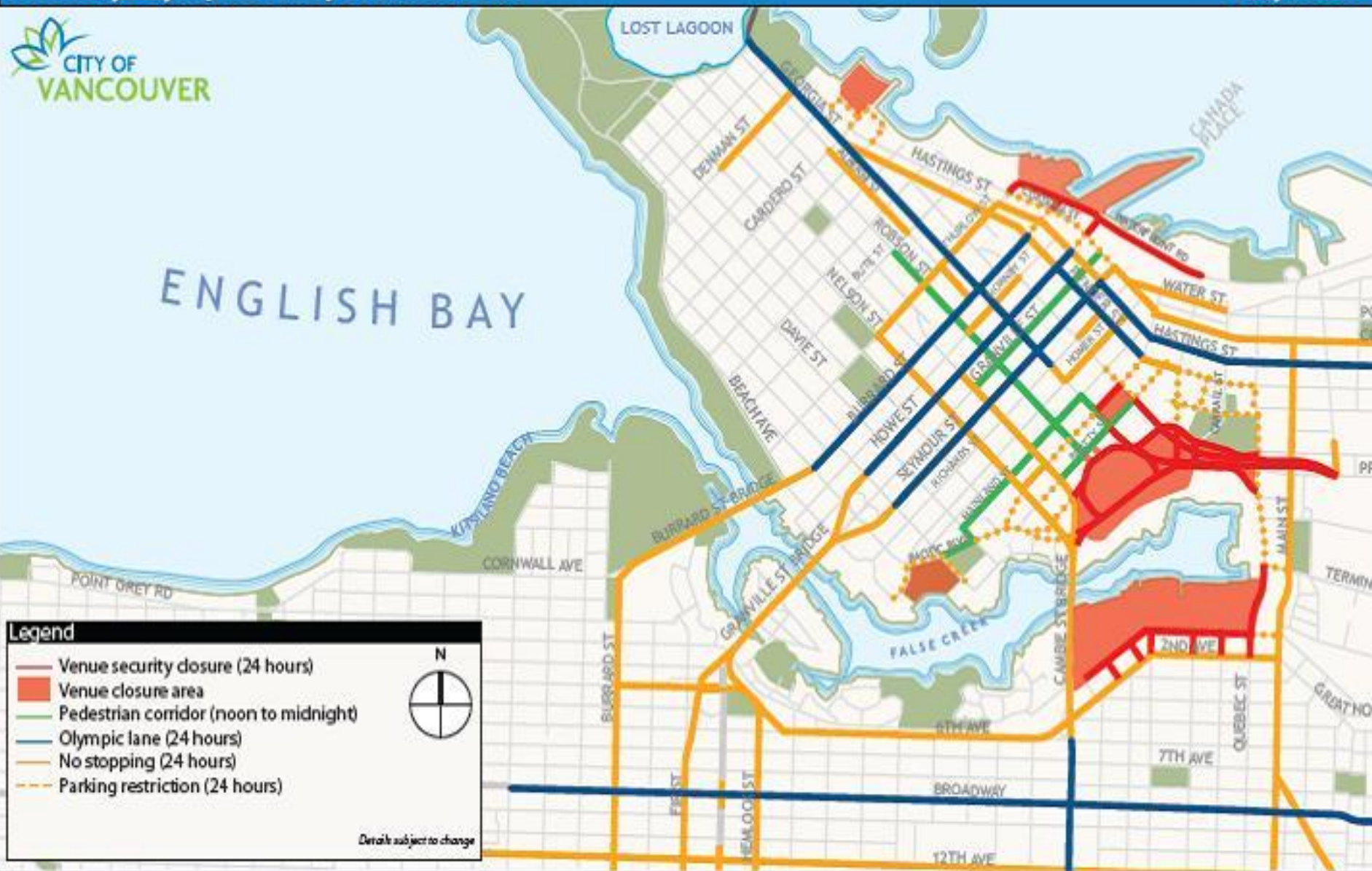
# Regional Scope of Games

## Key Olympic Dates: Metro Vancouver

- Phased Road closures Jan 1 to Mar 1
- Olympic Lanes Feb 4 to Mar 1
- Parking/stopping restrictions Feb 4 to Mar 1
- OPENING Ceremonies Feb 12
- Pedestrian corridors Feb 12 to 28
- Transit service changes Jan 1 to Feb 28
- CLOSING Ceremonies Feb 28

# Transit Enhancements

- Canada Line SkyTrain
- Jan 1 Additional SkyTrain cars
- Jan 21 City's 2010 Streetcar
- Feb 1 Enhanced NightBus
- Feb 1 Bus detours (25 routes)
- Feb 8 to 28 SeaBus



# Transit Enhancements (cont'd)

- Feb 12 to 28
  - Expo/Millennium SkyTrain
    - Extended hours 5:08am to 2:16am
    - Increased capacity and frequency
  - West Coast Express
    - 6 trips weekdays
    - 9 trips Saturdays
    - 7 trips Sundays
  - 165 buses for surges in demand



# 2010 Games Transit Pass

- February 8 to March 21, 2010
  - On-sale beginning December 2009 at FareDealer vendors
  - Pre-orders on-line now (minimum of 25 or \$3,000)
- All existing passes and fares still available
