Unique Games Environment

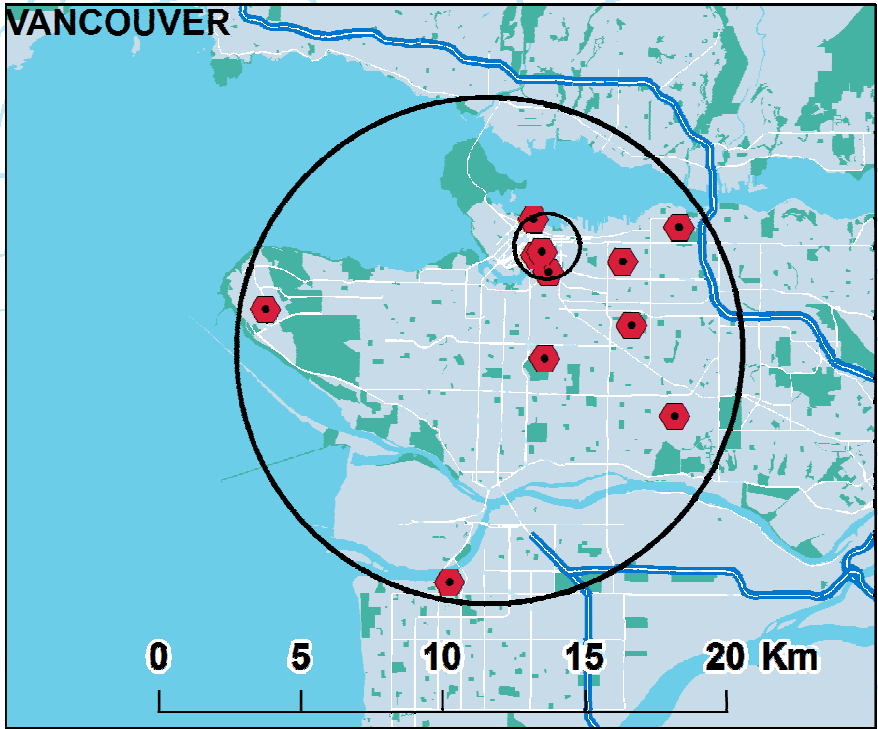
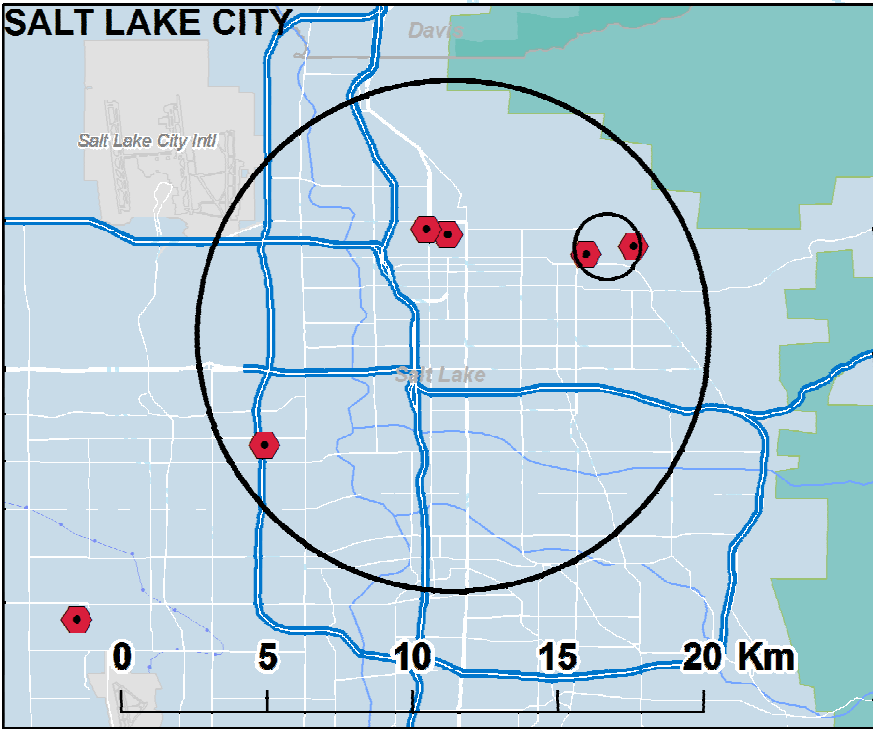
- Unique geographical aspects of the region
 - ✓ Lack of open space

Within 1 km	2 venues	4 venues

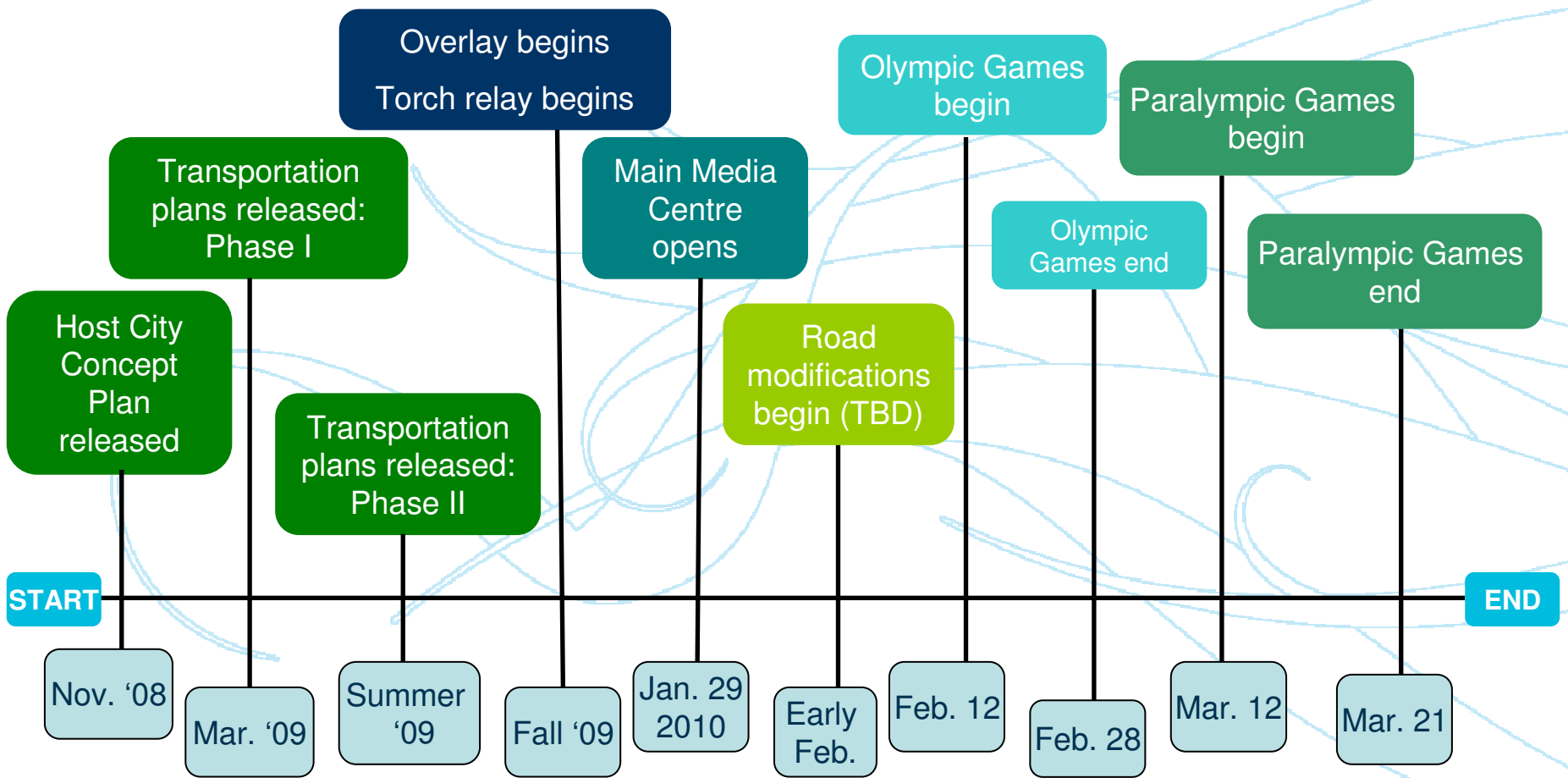


Venue Requirements

- Venue operations
 - ✓ Expanded activity footprint
- Security principles
 - ✓ Personal screening areas
 - ✓ Vehicle screening areas
 - ✓ Set back requirements
- Adjacent road capacity is reduced
 - ✓ Phased in venue activation - Jan 1 to Mar 31
