**OPEN HOUSE SUMMARY**

**Introduction**

VPA hosted a public open house in Delta at the Coast Tsawwassen Inn on March 29, 2007 to provide the community with an update on the Deltaport Third Berth Project (DP3). A total of 20 members of the public attended the open house. VPA staff, TSI Terminal Systems Inc. and technical consultants were available to answer questions. Members of the Deltaport Third Berth Project Community Liaison Committee (DCLC) were also in attendance. Display boards were set up and comment forms were provided to attendees.

**Input**

From comment and issue-tracking forms, comments and questions were received on matters regarding:

- Extent of the Project's environmental assessment
- Impacts of increased truck traffic on congestion and air quality
- Funding of rail crossings
- Impact of increased train noise
- Human health effects of burning of heavy bunker oils at sea
- Ship de-ballasting
- Interest in container storage areas removed from Deltaport Issues related to the safety of trucks driving to and from the Port
- Interest in short-haul shipping to alleviate train and truck transportation of containers through Delta
