

**Deltaport Third Berth Project
Open House Summary
June 26, 2010**

Overview

Port Metro Vancouver (PMV) and TSI Terminal Systems Inc. (TSI) hosted an open house on June 26, 2010 at the Deltaport Container Terminal. The open house was held from 10:00 am to 3:30 pm and was attended by approximately 3000 people from throughout the Lower Mainland including Delta, Surrey, Richmond, Vancouver, Langley, Burnaby and New Westminster. The event included bus tours, information booth with project information, terminal equipment demonstrations and other displays. Three PMV project resource staff and one member of the Deltaport Community Liaison Committee (DCLC) were available to speak with the public and to receive input on the Deltaport Third Berth Project (DP3) and six project staff from TSI and PMV provided bus tours.

At the DP3 information booth, passers-by were asked verbal questions regarding DP3. Their comments were recorded and project information handouts were provided. In total, PMV staff and DCLC interacted with 424 members of the public at the information booth.

Bus tours were conducted throughout the day to provide the public with an opportunity to see the new berth in operations. Three buses provided a total of 33 tours to approximately 1800 people.
