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The Liaison Group agreed on the following action items:

1. PMV to advise on status of landscape project once Matcon has confirmed they intend to proceed with their approved development.
2. PMV to review lighting from sources identified by area residents as problematic and advise of outcome:
  - Light at Columbia Containers
  - Street lighting along Commissioner Street
  - Lighting at security gates at east end of Commissioner Street
  - Lynnterm terminal on north shore
3. PMV to advise on possibility of trimming trees at various locations:
  - Cedar trees at Columbia Containers
  - Poplar trees at Coastal Containers
  - Trees on CPR property behind 2211 Wall Street  
(CPR also to advise of possible trimming)
4. CoV to advise on possibility of trimming vegetation at street-end parks along Wall Street
5. CPR to consider issuing bulletin to crews reminding of appropriate techniques for minimizing rail noise and disturbing residential neighbours particularly during summer hours when experienced crews are on vacation and residents are leaving windows open more frequently
6. PMV to advise on status of work at Neptune Terminals that has resulted in late-night noise audible in the Burrardview community.

7. PMV to advise on sampling sediments deposited at residential properties along the north side of Wall Street in order to identify source of sediments.
8. BCA to contact St. James Cottage Hospice to discuss coordinating efforts to request CoV install paved path in at least one street-end park to make wheelchair accessible. The park at the foot of Kamloops Street was identified as a good candidate for such improvements.
