The Liaison Group agreed upon the following action items:

1. *For Information:* The group discussed the impacts of the trucking staging activities during the Olympics and concluded that things had gone very smoothly. No action required.
2. *For Information:* PMV committed to following up on the requests from December for information on the soundscaping study to be completed for the Port and the CSR Initiatives underway.
3. The Liaison Group received information on the next two phases of road upgrades along the South Shore, between Victoria Drive and the McGill Overpass. PMV committed to circulate a proposed work schedule in May. PMV will follow up on the feasibility of quiet pavement in this area. PMV will also follow up on plans for the Columbia Container site, and lease expirations along the corridor.
4. BCA raised the issue of whether or not Lafarge intended to proceed with coverings for the aggregate bins at their facility. Residents of Cannery Row, and other community members, had requested these lids not be installed. PMV to confirm final outcome.
5. PMV will follow up regarding the status of the development of the Terminal Dock site.
6. CPR is now positioned to meet with residents re: tree removal along the bank. Bill Seely will coordinate a site visit with CPR staff and BCA residents on this matter.
7. *For Information:* Avant is holding an information open house on their development at 3490 E. Hasting St.
